

**STIPULATION**

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 16 day of June, 1989, by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and PAUL J. HALLGRIMSON, M.D., (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

**WITNESSETH:**

WHEREAS, Licensee is currently licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and holds license number 13344; and

WHEREAS, the Board was notified on January 19, 1989 that Licensee may have been over-prescribing certain controlled drugs to patients under his care; and

WHEREAS, the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board caused an investigation into said complaints to be made; and

WHEREAS, Licensee met before a medical review committee on May 18, 1989 in order to discuss such complaints; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said medical review committee meeting in lieu of the prosecution of formal charges at a hearing, the parties mutually desire to enter into a formal Stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of a formal hearing and other covenants and promises contained herein the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That, Licensee will bring the medical record keeping in his practice into compliance with the requirements of K.A.R. 100-24-1 in all respects.

2. That, Licensee will write no prescriptions for controlled substances in his office for Schedule II, III or IV drugs, except in cases of acute emergency at the Licensee's discretion.

3. That, Licensee will attend a mini-residency, at Licensee's expense, to be held in New Jersey at the University of Medicine and Dentistry School of Osteopathic Medicine, entitled "The Proper Prescribing of Controlled Dangerous Substances" at some time within the next year.

4. That, Licensee will submit to the Board, copies of all prescriptions for controlled substances on a weekly basis until further notice is given Licensee by the Board.

5. That, after Licensee has successfully completed the mini-residency program in Camden, New Jersey at the University of Medicine and Dentistry School of Osteopathic Medicine, Licensee's writing of prescriptions for controlled substances will be subject to review at the discretion of the Board.


6. That, as long as Licensee remains in strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, no formal adjudicative proceedings shall be initiated against Licensee based upon the aforementioned findings. Any violation of any of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation by the Licensee shall be prima facie evidence that a violation of the Healing Arts Act has occurred for which the Board may suspend, revoke, or limit the license of the Licensee.

7. That, it is further agreed and understood that the provisions of this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to. This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other agreements and understandings not set forth herein. This Stipulation may be modified or amended only by written instrument signed by the parties hereto.

8. That, this Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended, or rescinded by the parties hereto. Licensee may request an appearance before the Board to discuss modification, amendment, or rescission of this Stipulation and the Board will give such request due consideration.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Stipulation on the date indicated below their signature, it being strictly understood that the effective date of this Stipulation will be the date it has been signed by both parties hereto.

ENFORCEMENT ORDER

1. That, Licensee will bring the medical record keeping in his practice into compliance with the requirements of K.A.R. 100-24-1 in all respects.

2. That, Licensee will write no prescriptions for controlled substances in his office for Schedule II, III or IV drugs, except in cases of acute emergency at the Licensee's discretion.
