**FINAL ORDER**

**NOW ON THIS** 12th day of August, 2006, this matter comes before the Board upon the request of William Duane Harris, P.A. to change his license from inactive to active. Mr. Harris appears in person. Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

The Board is advised that the parties have agreed to conditions and limitations upon his license, under which his practice as a physician assistant with an active license would be appropriate. The Board adopts those conditions and limitations as the order of the Board. Those conditions and limitations are as follows:

5. Licensee agrees to abstain from the consumption of alcohol and from the use of controlled substance, narcotic, or mind-altering or potentially addicting drug or medication, unless prescribed by a physician for a medically necessary purpose and taken pursuant to the direction of that physician.

(Confidential) Licensee has the affirmative duty not to ingest any other substance which will cause a body fluid sample to test positive for a controlled or illegal substance or alcohol.

### LIMITATIONS

8. For a period of at least five years, Licensee shall not actively practice as a physician assistant unless he is directly supervised by a physician on site. Licensee shall not practice at any location where the supervising physician is at a remote location.

9. For a period of at least five years, Licensee is prohibited from ordering, prescribing, dispensing or administering medications to any employee, family member, significant other, or any person with whom Licensee has a personal relationship.

10. Licensee shall only prescribe, order, dispense, or administer prescriptions for persons with whom he has a physician-patient relationship and for whom he maintains a medical record.

11. For a period of at least five years, Licensee is prohibited from prescribing, ordering, dispensing, or administering medications to himself, including sample medications. Licensee shall arrange to have a personal physician oversee his health care.


12. These limitations and monitoring provisions are not self-terminating. These limitations and monitoring provisions may be modified or terminated only by further order of the Board. For any period of time that Licensee is not actively practicing as a physician assistant in Kansas, the monitoring provisions and limitations will remain in effect, but will not be counted towards reducing the five-year time frame.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for

judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
