**AGREED ORDER**

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") sitting in a Conference Proceeding to hear the request of William Joseph Harrison, D.O. ("Licensee") to terminate his Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation") and two modifications of the same which were filed with the Board on February 12, 1991, March 11, 1992, and October 31, 1992, respectively. Licensee is represented by counsel, Ms. Laura Cross of Miller, Dollarhide, Dawson & Shaw, of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and Mr. Steven D. Rosel of Topeka. Mr. Rosel is in attendance; Licensee is not present. The Board is represented by Kevin K. LaChance, Disciplinary Counsel. After consideration of documentation presented to the Board, part of which is protected under the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2836(i) the Board orders as follows:

1. Licensee agrees to place his license in an inactive status. Licensee's agreement to this term is represented by his signature at the end of this document.
2. Upon the placing of Licensee's license in an inactive status, the Board will terminate the aforementioned Stipulation and its modifications.
3. The Board and Licensee agree that, if Licensee at some future date desires to change the status of his license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of

Kansas, that the Board may consider all information in its investigative, disciplinary, and public record files in making a determination as to whether such a request to change license status should be approved. Further, Licensee agrees that the Board may in its discretion consider any information arising between the time of the filing of this document and his request for change of status **(Confidential)**


based on conduct since the date of this Order.
