JOURNAL ENTRY

NOW, on this 7th day of January, 2003, comes Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") and finds and states as follows:

1. On November 5, 2002, a copy of the Notice of Conference Hearing on the Petition filed October 9, 2002, was mailed to Dillis L. Hart, M.D. ("Respondent"), P.O. Box 937, Boise City, Oklahoma, 73933-0937. The notice was not returned in the mail to the Board office as undeliverable.

2. Respondent did not attend the Conference Hearing conducted on December 14, 2002 at which time the Board found Respondent to be in default and issued a Proposed Default Order which was filed on December 18, 2002.

3. A copy of the Proposed Default Order was mailed to Respondent on December 19, 2002, at P.O. Box 937, Boise City, Oklahoma 73933-0937. The Proposed Default Order was not returned in the mail to the Board office as undeliverable.

4. K.S.A. 77-520 provides that a party against whom a Proposed Default Order is issued may file a written motion within seven days after service of the order requesting that the order be vacated and if a motion is not so filed, the Proposed Default Order shall become effective.

5. Respondent has not filed a motion requesting that the Proposed Default Order be vacated and, therefore, by operation of law, the Proposed Default Order became effective January 3, 2003, and Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas is revoked as of that date.

PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

NOW ON THIS Fourteenth Day of December 2002, this matter comes before the Board upon a Petition. Stacy I. Cook, Litigation Counsel, appears for Petitioner. Respondent Dillis L. Hart, M.D. does not appear.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The Board served upon Respondent a Notice of Hearing at his last known address. By Respondent's non-appearance, the Board finds that Respondent is in default.
2. The Board issued a Final Order dated August 18, 1998 in which certain limitations were imposed upon Respondent's license. Respondent was ordered to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2000, and costs in the amount of \$2107.
3. Respondent's duty to pay the fine and costs was stayed pending judicial review.
4. Upon completion of judicial review, in which the Board's order was affirmed, the stay was terminated, and the Board issued an order dated October 25, 2000 requiring Respondent to pay the fine and costs within thirty days.
5. Respondent has not paid the fine and costs as ordered.
6. The Board concludes that it may revoke, suspend, or limit a license upon a finding

that the licensee has violated a lawful Board order.


7. The Board takes official notice of prior disciplinary actions against Respondent, and determines that it is appropriate to revoke the license of Respondent.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the license of Dillis L. Hart is hereby revoked.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Proposed Default Order. A party upon whom a proposed default order is served may file a written motion to vacate the proposed order within 7 days following service of the order. Any such motion must be served upon the Board's executive director at 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603. If the order is not vacated, or if no motion requesting that the motion be vacated is timely filed, then the proposed order becomes the Final Order of the Board upon the expiration of time for filing a motion to vacate.
