EMERGENCY ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION AND
EMERGENCY PROCEEDINGS

NOW on this 8th day of February, 2019, this matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) in the context of a motion presented on behalf of the Disciplinary Panel of the Board for an order [REDACTED] (“Motion”). Dr. Ronald Hartman, M.D. (“Licensee”) appears in person and by counsel, Dan Sanders. Board litigation counsel, Katie Baylie, appeared to in support of the motion on behalf of the Board Disciplinary Panel. The members of the Disciplinary Panel were recused from the Board’s deliberations of this matter. Upon consideration of the filings, exhibits thereto, the statements of counsel, testimony of Licensee at the hearing, and the agency record, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The Board finds, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536(c), that there is reasonable cause to believe that:
 - a. grounds exist for disciplinary action; and
 - b. the Licensee’s immediate continuation in practice would constitute an imminent danger to the public health and safety.
2. The grounds that support such reasonable cause include, but are not limited to the following:
 - a. The facts and documentary evidence as set forth and incorporated in the

Motion, all such facts and documentary evidence incorporated here by reference.

b. The testimony of Licensee at the hearing on this date.

3. The Board further finds that, in addition to the facts and law referenced above, the policy consideration of the Board's duty of public protection provide reasonable grounds to justify the requested emergency suspension.

4. Therefore, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-536(b), Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery is temporarily suspended pending further proceedings and/or further Order of the Board.

5. A notice of expedited hearing to determine whether the temporary suspension shall remain in place is filed and served contemporaneously herewith.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the license of Dr. Ronald Hartman, M.D., is hereby **SUSPENDED** on a temporary basis pending a hearing to determine if there is adequate cause for the suspension to remain in effect.


