FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 10th day of June 2006, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing ("Board") the Petition filed by Charles W. Hastings, M.D. ("Licensee) to terminate requirements imposed by the Amended Consent Order adopted by the Board in Final Order filed May 2, 2005. Licensee appears in person and by counsel, John P. Hastings, Leawood. Kelli J. Stevens, Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of counsel, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

- 1. On April 27, 2005, Licensee entered into an Amended Consent Order that was approved by the Board at its meeting April 23, 2005 and adopted in a Final Order that was filed May 2, 2005.
- 2. In the Amended Consent Order, Licensee agreed to attend and successfully complete a continuing education course on proper medical record documentation; to photograph all skin lesions prior to biopsy and/or treatment; and to have his practice monitored to include monthly random chart review and quarterly monitoring reports.
- 3. Licensee has attended and successfully completed a continuing education course on proper medical record documentation and has met the other requirements imposed by the Amended Consent Order.

The Amended Consent Order and the requirements imposed upon 4.

Licensee by such Order should be terminated.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee's Petition to terminate

requirements imposed by the Amended Consent Order should be granted and the

Amended Consent Order should have no further force or effect.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective

upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order

by filing a petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial

Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 et seq. A petition for

judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final

Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the

Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for

reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.
