FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 29th day of May, 2008, this matter comes on for a conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) upon the request of Licensee Thomas Heidewald, M.D. to terminate the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order that was filed with the Board on December 13, 1999. Licensee appears *pro se* by telephone. Dan Riley, Litigation Counsel appears for the Board.

After having reviewed the agency record, hearing the statements of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Presiding Officer finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Licensee agreed to a Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order (“Stipulation”) that was approved by the Board and filed on December 13, 1999.
2. In the Stipulation, Licensee agreed to a number of items, including a public censure, a fine, **(Confidential)**

3. The terms contained in the Stipulation were to remain in effect for at least two years.

4. On April 25, 2008, Licensee submitted a letter to the Board requesting that the requirements of his Stipulation be terminated.

11. The Stipulation and the requirements imposed upon Licensee by such Stipulation should be terminated.



A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a Petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.
