FINAL ORDER

NOW on this 10th day of August 2017, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the Petition for Discipline filed against Alexander Hemme, D.C.’s (“Licensee”) license to practice chiropractic medicine in the State of Kansas. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel (“Petitioner”), appears on behalf of the Petitioner Board. Licensee appears in person and through counsel, Andrew Moskow.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is or has been entitled to engage in the practice of chiropractic in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 01-05779 on approximately February 1, 2016, and having last renewed such license on approximately December 1, 2016.

2. On or about April 25, 2017, a Petition for discipline was filed in this matter alleging that Dr. Hemme had violated the Consent Order he entered into with the Board on or about December 30, 2015.

3. The Petition alleged that Dr. Hemme had violated K.S.A. 65-2836(k) by failing to ensure [REDACTED] as required by the terms and conditions of the 2015 Consent Order and the 2016 Final Order.

4. The Board finds that there is sufficient evidence to support a finding of a violation of K.S.A. 65-2836(k), by failing to ensure [REDACTED]

5. The Board concludes that the appropriate discipline for the violation is a fine of \$250 to be paid within 30 days of the date of this order.


6. The Board further finds that Dr. Hemme has complied with the remaining requirements of both the 2015 Consent Order and the 2016 Final Order and that Dr. Hemme has not further obligation under either order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee pay a **CIVIL FINE** of \$250 within 30 days of the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, that the 2015 Consent Order is hereby terminated.
