**EMERGENCY ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION
AND EMERGENCY PROCEEDINGS**

This matter comes before the Presiding Officer of the Board, Kimberly Templeton, M.D., a member of the agency head appointed to preside pursuant to K.S.A. 77-514(g),¹ on a motion filed on September 24, 2020, (“Motion”) on behalf of the Disciplinary Panel of the Board (“Petitioner”) for an *Ex Parte* Emergency Order of Suspension of the license of Cassady Holloway, LRT (“Licensee”) to practice radiologic technology and for Emergency Proceedings. The Motion incorporated the Petition for discipline filed on the same date (“Petition”). Upon consideration of the agency record, including all filings and attached exhibits, the presiding officer finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536(c), there is reasonable cause to believe that:
 - a. grounds exist for disciplinary action; and
 - b. the immediate continuation in practice by Licensee would constitute an imminent danger to the public health and safety.

2. The cause to believe that grounds exist for disciplinary action and the Licensee's immediate continuation in practice would constitute an imminent danger to the public health and safety include the following:

a. The facts and documentary evidence as set forth and incorporated in the Motion and the Petition are incorporated here by reference, subject to the Protective Order that has been entered in this case.

b. On or about April 20, 2017, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board. Under the Consent Order, Licensee was required to enter into and comply with all terms and conditions **CONFIDENTIAL** and follow all recommendations for a period of at least five years. Specifically, and in pertinent part, Licensee was required to:

c. Additionally, Licensee was required to **CONFIDENTIAL**

d. On or about January 15, 2020, the Board was notified **CONFIDENTIAL**

e. **CONFIDENTIAL**

f. On or about September 1, 2020, the Board was notified **CONFIDENTIAL**

3. There is reasonable cause to believe that Licensee **CONFIDENTIAL** become non-compliant with her **CONFIDENTIAL** contract, and her Consent Order with the Board, despite significant efforts of remediation, to the extent **CONFIDENTIAL** has determined she is not safe to practice, and otherwise violated the Radiologic Technologist Practice Act as described in the Motion and Petition. There is reasonable cause to believe that Licensee's immediate continuation in practice would constitute an imminent danger to the public health. The presiding officer further finds that, in addition to the facts and law referenced above, K.S.A. 65-7301 *et seq.*, K.S.A. 65-7313, and K.A.R. 100-73-6, and the policy consideration of the Board's duty of public protection provide supplemental reasonable grounds in law and policy to justify the requested emergency suspension under the circumstances of this case.
4. Therefore, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536(b), Licensee's license to practice radiologic technology is immediately temporarily suspended pending further proceedings and/or further Order of the Board.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Motion is **SUSTAINED**. The radiologic technology license of Cassady Holloway, LRT, is hereby **SUSPENDED** on a temporary basis pending further proceedings and/or further Order of the Board.


