FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE

NOW on this 17th day of June 2011, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Pamela Howell, (“Applicant”) for a license to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas. Licensee does not appear. Janith A. Lewis, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements and arguments of Ms. Lewis, hearing the testimony of the Applicant and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions and order:

1. On or about November 9, 2010, Applicant submitted to the Board an application for a license to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on May 18, 2011.
2. Applicant’s last known mailing address provided to the Board is: confidential
Lee’s Summit, Missouri 64801.
3. Applicant has been practicing as a radiologic technologist in the State of Missouri since 2004. However, Missouri does not require licensure to practice radiologic technology.

4. Applicant completed her radiologic technology education and training at Sacred Heart Hospital School of Radiologic Technology in Fort Madison, Iowa from June 19, 1972 to June 19, 1974.

5. The American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (“ARRT”) certified to the Board that Applicant successfully completed the Radiology examination on July 21, 1983 with confidential

6. Applicant currently holds ARRT registration in radiography.

7. Applicant is unable to obtain original verification of her education in radiologic technology at Sacred Heart Hospital School of Radiologic Technology because the school is no longer in existence.

8. However, the ARRT verified to the Board that Applicant completed her education and training at Sacred Heart Hospital School of Radiologic Technology, which is an approved school by the ARRT.

9. The evidence demonstrates that, in accord with the requirement of K.S.A. 65-7305(a)(3), Applicant has satisfactorily completed a course of study in radiography, radiation therapy or nuclear medicine technology which is approved by the board and which contains a curriculum no less stringent than the standards of existing organizations which approve radiologic technology programs.

10. The evidence demonstrates that Applicant is qualified to be granted licensure as a radiologic technologist in Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby granted licensure as a radiologic technologist in Kansas.


