ORDER GRANTING CHANGE OF LICENSE DESIGNATION/TYPE
AND FURTHER PROCEEDINGS

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NOW on this 12th day of December 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the Application for Change of Designation/Type filed by Jeremy Howes, MD (“Licensee”). Licensee appears in person, and through counsel, Mark Stafford of Simpson, Logback, Lynch, Norris, P.A. Jessica Bryson, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record and exhibits admitted, hearing the testimony of Licensee and arguments of both counsel, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about October 21, 2006, Licensee was issued Kansas license No. 04-32101 to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. On or about June 27, 2014, Licensee was involved in automobile accident in which he drove his vehicle through the side of a residential home. At the conclusion of the

investigation into the accident, Licensee was arrested for suspicion of DUI, by the Wichita Police Department.

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4. On or about July 3, 2014, Licensee requested that his license designation/type be changed from active to inactive. Licensee currently holds an inactive license to practice medicine and surgery.

5. On or about July 17, 2014, Licensee hand-delivered to the Board an application for change of designation/type to change his license from inactive back to active.

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7. On or about September 8, 2014, Licensee's application for change of designation/type was deemed complete and filed with the Board.

8. On or about September 18, 2014, a Response to Application for Change of Designation/Type to Practice Medicine and Surgery ("Response") was filed by Respondent.

9. At the conference hearing on this matter, Board Exhibits 1 through 6 and 11 through 14 were admitted over the objection of Licensee's counsel. The Board will review the exhibits and determine the appropriate evidentiary weight to give to each exhibit.

10. Additionally, at the conference hearing on this matter, Licensee Exhibit A was admitted over the objection of the Respondent. The Board will review the exhibit and determine the appropriate evidentiary weight to give that exhibit.

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22. The Board concludes that the adjudication of allegations of unprofessional conduct, as generally alleged in the Response, shall be held in abeyance until such time as the proceedings in this matter resume.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS Confidential this


matter will be returned to the full Board for further proceedings as set forth above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board shall maintain jurisdiction over this matter to conduct additional proceedings and issue further order(s) deemed necessary and appropriate in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee is hereby granted a change of designation/type of license from an inactive license to an active license.
