FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING

NOW on this 11th day of December, 2015, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Jeremy Howes, M.D. ("Licensee") for termination of the monitoring requirement contained in the Final Order filed on April 17, 2015. Licensee appears in person and *through counsel* Mark Stafford of Simpson, Logback, Lynch, Norris, P.A. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

- 1. On October 19, 2015, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the monitoring provisions contained in the Final Order.
- 2. On November 10, 2015, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Monitoring.
- 3. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all monitoring requirements of the Final Order and concludes that termination of the monitoring requirement is warranted in the circumstances.

4. Licensee remains required to take a communication course as agreed to in the

Final Order. Licensee shall enroll in the "Case Western Reserve University "Managing Difficult

Communications in Medical Practice: Controlling Anger, Avoiding Outbursts, Communicating

Appropriately" as soon as possible. These hours shall be in addition to those hours required for

renewal of licensure. This shall be at Licensee's own expense. Licensee shall notify the Board

of the date of the course Licensee has enrolled in within 30 days of the filing of this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF

HEALING ARTS that the monitoring requirements imposed by the Final Order filed on April

17, 2015, is hereby TERMINATED and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for

compliance with monitoring.
