FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 8th day of December, 1995, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the Application of Lance Human, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Lori Miskel McNett, Associate Counsel, appears for and on behalf of the Board. Applicant appears pro se.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Applicant originally filed an application for endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas 1984. Applicant was granted a temporary permit H-29266 on January 7, 1985.

2. Applicant was found guilty of attempted murder in South Africa in 1976.
3. Applicant's South African medical license was revoked in March 1980.
4. Applicant failed to disclose either his conviction or the revocation of his license on his application for licensure in the State of Kansas.
5. Applicant was denied a permanent Kansas license on August 24, 1985.
6. Applicant reapplied for licensure by endorsement on or about September 15, 1995.
7. Applicant has not engaged in the practice of the healing arts since 1985.
8. On December 8, 1995, a Conference Hearing was held in the above-captioned matter to enable Applicant to address the Board prior to the Board taking final action on Applicant's application for licensure by endorsement.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

There is probable cause to believe grounds exist to deny Applicant's application for licensure by endorsement. Specifically, the following grounds may constitute a basis for denial or limitation of license pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2836:

1. Applicant has been convicted of a felony, whether or not related to the practice of the healing arts, in violation of K.S.A. 65-2836(c).
2. Applicant has had a license to practice the healing arts revoked in another country, in violation of K.S.A. 65-2836(j).
3. Applicant is not licensed and has not been engaged in the active practice of any branch of the healing arts in any other state, territory, District of Columbia, or other country, and is therefore not entitled to licensure by endorsement provided for by K.S.A. 65-2833.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

A. Adequate information has been provided to the Board to justify denial of a permanent license to Applicant to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant's application for licensure by endorsement is therefore denied.

B. Applicant may reapply for licensure at any time. However, in order to provide the Board with more complete application materials from which to render a decision, the Board requests that the following actions be taken by Applicant prior to any reapplication:

- (i) Applicant must successfully complete the Special Purpose Examination (SPEX).
- (ii) Applicant must successfully complete the Colorado Physician Evaluation Program (CPEP), or another program approved by the Board designed to assess Applicant's current medical competency.
- (iii) Confidential

C. Compliance with (B)(i), (ii) and (iii) does not guarantee Applicant of favorable action regarding his application.

D. That the findings herein above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

E. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 (fifteen) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
