ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 17th day of February, 1996, for conference proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-511 (a)(2)(B), the request of Shahzad Islam, M.D. (hereinafter "Applicant"), for Board approval of his postgraduate training as meeting the minimum requirements for licensure in the State of Kansas.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Board. Applicant does not appear.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Applicant's Application for Licensure by Endorsement was received by the Board on November 22, 1995, and his request for approval of postgraduate training was received on January 16, 1996.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:15 a.m. on February 17, 1996 was filed herein on February 2, 1996 and served upon Applicant that same date.

3. Although Applicant has appropriately applied for license by endorsement of his FLEX examination, Applicant does not have a license in any other state, territory, District of Columbia or country and is not eligible for endorsement under K.S.A. 65-2833. Therefore, Applicant must meet the requirements for license set forth in K.S.A. 65-2873.

4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2873(c)(1), Applicant must complete three years of postgraduate training as approved by the Board.

5. Applicant is not a graduate of an accredited healing arts school or college and must meet the requirements of K.S.A. 65-2873(c).

6. Applicant has completed two and one-half years of approved residency training at the University of Kansas School of Medicine at Wichita, Kansas.

7. Applicant requests that his one-year internship training as Resident House Officer at the Civil Hospital, Karachi, Pakistan fulfill one of the three years of postgraduate training requirements under K.S.A. 65-2873(c)(1).

8. The Board finds that the above-described training does not satisfy the requirements of postgraduate training and therefore, his request should be denied.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Applicant's request for approval of postgraduate training is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant's Application will be considered upon completion of his 3 years of residency training at the University of Kansas Medical Center.

This Order is effective upon service. Any party may file a Petition for Reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 1995 Supp. 77-529 with the Board within fifteen (15) days of service of this Order. Such petition is not a prerequisite for seeking judicial review.


