**FINAL ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR TERMINATION  
OF INTERNAL MEDICINE PRACTICE LIMITATION, AND MONITORING**

NOW on this 9th day of August 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Jack Jaeger, M.D. (“Licensee”) for termination of the monitoring requirements contained in the Consent Order filed July 25, 2011. Licensee appears in person and with counsel, Carol Ruth Bonebrake. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is licensed to actively engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 04-28323.
2. Licensee’s last known mailing address provided to the Board is: **Confidential**  
Garden City, KS 67846.
3. On or about July 25, 2011, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board. Which included a limitation that Licensee not practice internal medicine unless such practice was monitored by a Board-approved practice monitor.

4. The terms of the Consent Order allow Licensee to petition the Board for modification or termination of the Order after a period of one (1) year.

5. On May 13, 2013, Licensee submitted a request to terminate the internal medicine practice limitation, and monitoring requirement contained in paragraph 55 of the Consent Order.

6. On May 15, 2013, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Monitoring.

7. The Board finds that Licensee has successfully completed all requirements of paragraph 55 of the Consent Order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Licensee's request for termination of the internal medicine practice monitoring requirement contained in paragraph 55 of the Consent Order filed July 25, 2011, is hereby **GRANTED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the limitation on internal medicine practice on Licensee's license is hereby **TERMINATED**.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
