FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

NOW on this 12^h day of April 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Wingrove T. Jarvis, M.D. (“Applicant”) for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about January 7, 2013, Applicant submitted an application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on March 15, 2013.
2. In July of 1993, Applicant graduated from the University of West Indies, Barbados with a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery.
3. Applicant passed all 3 steps of the USMLE within 10 years.
4. Applicant has not completed any ACGME accredited postgraduate training.

5. Applicant completed an internship at Princess Margaret Hospital in Nassau, Bahamas in December of 1994. Applicant then completed in April of 2004 a four-year residency in Trauma and Orthopaedics in Glasgow, Scotland, which is accredited by the General Medical Council of the United Kingdom. In July of 2006, Applicant completed another General Medical Council accredited residency program in Trauma and Orthopaedics in England. Applicant participated in, and successfully completed one-year fellowship in Orthopaedic Trauma Surgery at the University of Louisville Hospital in Louisville, Kentucky in July of 2007. In July of 2008, Applicant then completed a one-year fellowship in Orthopaedic Surgery of the Spine at Duck University Hospital in Durham, North Carolina.

6. Applicant currently maintains an active license to practice medicine in the State of Kentucky, having been licensed there in 2008. There are no reported disciplinary actions against Applicant's Kentucky license.


7. Applicant has practiced as an attending physician in Orthopaedics, Trauma and Spine Surgery at Jackson Purchase Medical Center in Mayfield, Kentucky since January of 2010.

8. At the conference hearing, Applicant testified that he had recently been approved for licensure in the States of Pennsylvania, Ohio, Virginia and New Hampshire.

9. The Board finds that Applicant has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.


