NOW, on this 15th day of October, 1994, comes on for conference proceedings the request of Sheeja John (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to S.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Applicant does not appear. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appears on behalf of the Board. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the files and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1. A request for a second temporary registration was received from Applicant on October 5, 1994 to continue to practice as an occupational therapist in the State of Kansas.

2. A Voluntary Entry of Appearance and Waiver of Notice was filed October 14, 1994 by Applicant consenting to the Board conducting a conference proceeding on the request for a temporary registration at 1:15 p.m. on October 15, 1994.

3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a occupational therapist, but has not passed an examination

required and approved by the Board for registration as an occupational therapist pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5406.

4. Applicant was granted a temporary registration on November 3, 1993 which expires on November 3, 1994.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408 (d) no more than one such temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

Applicant should be granted a second temporary registration effective November 3, 1994 and to expire on November 3, 1995.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a second temporary registration for the purposes of holding oneself out as a occupational therapist be issued to Applicant effective from November 3, 1994 and to expire on November 3, 1995 upon payment of the required fee for such second temporary registration.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
