

but does not authorize the person receiving the permit to engage in the private practice of the healing arts.

4. Pursuant to Board records, upon request by Licensee, Licensee was mailed an application for permanent license on April 27, 1992.

5. On September 18, 1992, the application for permanent license was deemed complete and temporary permit number 9249821 was issued to Licensee under the provisions of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2811(a)(1) to expire February 15, 1993.

6. By letter dated August 14, 1992 and received in the Board office August 24, 1992, Licensee requested that temporary permit number 9249821 be made retroactively effective to February 12, 1992.

7. In the aforementioned letter Licensee also requested that temporary permit number 3015 be extended from July 1, 1992 until September 18, 1992 due to the fact Licensee was engaged in a post graduate training program in the Department of Radiation Oncology at the University of Kansas Medical Center during this period.

8. The failure of Licensee to advise the Board of his entry into the residency program of Radiation Oncology which will not conclude until June 30, 1993 was due to inadvertency and mistake.

9. The temporary certificate issued to Licensee as evidence of the issuance of temporary permit number 3015 did not state the date on which said certificate would expire.

10. That the request of Licensee to extend temporary permit number 3015 for the continuation of post graduate training from July 1, 1992 through and including September 17, 1992 should be granted and the Board's records should be modified to reflect that said temporary permit was in full force and effect continuously from June 26, 1989 through September 17, 1992.

11. The request for issuance of temporary permit number 9249821 retroactively to February 12, 1992 should be denied for the reason that under K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2811(a)(1) said temporary permit cannot be issued until Licensee has provided to the Board proof of meeting all of the requirements therefor and that such requirements were not met until September 18, 1992.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. That temporary permit number 3015 originally effective June 26, 1989 to expire June 30, 1992 be extended to and including September 17, 1992.

C. The request for retroactive issuance of temporary permit number 9249821 issued September 18, 1992 be denied.

D. This is a Final Order and effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
