FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this 18TH day of October, 2003, this matter comes before the Board to review the Initial Order issued by Charlotte Seago, M.D., Presiding Officer, and to assess costs of the proceeding. Kelli J. Benintendi appears for the Board. Respondent appears in person and through counsel, Stanley E. Oyler, Topeka, Kansas.

Having the record before it, and upon a motion duly made, seconded and adopted by a majority of the Board present and participating, the findings, conclusions and order stated in the Initial Order are adopted as the findings, conclusions, and Final Order of the Board. As provided by K.S.A. 65-2846, costs are assessed against Respondent in the amount of \$7,376.55 due and payable to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts on or before November 24, 2003.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Miles J. Jones, M.D. is hereby revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Miles J. Jones, M.D. pay costs to the Board in the amount of \$7,376.55.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-610 *et seq.* Reconsideration of the Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must

be served upon the Board's Executive Director, Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., at 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603.
