**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RENEW REGISTRATION
AND TO OBTAIN REQUIRED CONTINUING EDUCATION**

NOW, on this 14th day of April, 1993, comes on for consideration before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director for the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"), the request submitted by Kelly A. Jones (hereafter "Registrant") for an extension of time for renewal of registration number 18-00086 and for an extension of time to provide proof of having attained the required continuing education units the past year. Registrant did not appear.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On February 8, 1993, the Board received Registrant's written request for reconsideration of the Order of Cancellation filed February 15, 1993, an extension of time for renewal of registration and for an extension of time to submit the required continuing education units necessary for renewal.

2. Registrant was on extended maternity leave from August 1992 through January 1993 due to complications from

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childbirth which prevented her from obtaining the required continuing education units.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. That the Order of Cancellation entered should be set aside as null and void and Registrant's registration as an occupational therapy assistant remain in effect from and after February 15, 1993 until Tuesday, June 1, 1993 as hereafter stated.

C. That an extension to submit the required continuing education units necessary for renewal be granted to Registrant until Tuesday, June 1, 1993 at 4:30 p.m. Such proof of completion shall be delivered, either by mail or in person to the Board office at 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.

D. That an extension of time in order to renew registration number 18-00086 be granted to Registrant until Tuesday, June 1, 1993 at 4:30 p.m. Said renewal shall be delivered, either by mail or in person to the Board office at 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.

E. That such extensions above referenced are granted pursuant to K.A.R. 100-54-7 which allow for extension of time in the event of an illness or accident during the 12-month period prior to the renewal registration which made it impossible or extremely difficult to obtain CEU hours and obtain renewal of registration.

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
F. In the event Registrant fails to meet the requirements addressed in (B) and (C) above, Registrant's registration to practice as an occupational therapy assistant in the state of Kansas will be immediately cancelled and Registrant would be required to reinstate in order to again practice as an occupational therapy assistant in Kansas.

G. Registrant is entitled to an administrative review of this Order if a written request is received in the Board office within fifteen (15) days of the service of this Order upon Registrant.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
