FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING

NOW on this 13th day of June 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Terri Jones-Meineke, LRT (“Licensee”) for termination of the monitoring requirement contained in the Consent Order filed on June 24, 2013. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by the Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-7301 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is licensed to engage in the practice of radiologic technology in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 22-04486.
2. On or about June 24, 2013, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board which provided Licensee with a temporary license and a full license upon ratification of the Consent Order by the Board.
3. On August 13, 2013, the Board accepted and ratified the Consent Order.

4. The Consent Order was entered to resolve concerns regarding Licensee's disclosure of an arrest for Driving Under the Influence, which occurred in December 2009. Further, Licensee disclosed that she had been placed on probation with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists ("ARRT").

5. Under the terms of her Consent Order, Licensee agreed to comply with all terms

6. The terms of the Consent Order allowed Licensee to petition the Board for modification or termination after one (1) year.

7. From July 12, 2013, through April 14, 2014, four (4) quarterly reports regarding Licensee's compliance with her Consent Order were submitted to the Board Confidential

8. On April 15, 2014, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the monitoring provisions contained in the Consent Order.

9. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and concludes that termination of the monitoring requirements are warranted in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed on June 24, 2013, are hereby **TERMINATED** and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.


