- 2. In the Consent Order, Licensee agreed that his license to practice as a physician assistant was limited to inactive status until otherwise approved by the Board. Further, Licensee agreed that if he petitioned the Board to change his status to active, the Board could impose additional limitations and monitoring requirements as conditions to granting Licensee a status change to active.
