FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 9th day of June 2007, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing (“Board”) the request to engage in active practice in the state of Kansas filed by Jerald R. Jones, P.A. (“Licensee”). Licensee appears in person *pro se*. Diane Bellquist, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. On December 6, 2006, Licensee agreed to a Consent Order that was approved by the Board at its meeting February 10, 2007 and was filed February 12, 2007.

2. In the Consent Order, Licensee agreed that his license to practice as a physician assistant was limited to inactive status until otherwise approved by the Board. Further, Licensee agreed that if he petitioned the Board to change his status to active, the Board could impose additional limitations and monitoring requirements as conditions to granting Licensee a status change to active.

5. Licensee’s license should be placed on active status at such time as he has met the requirements of K.S.A. 65-28a03 by presenting to the Board a Physician Request Form signed by Licensee’s proposed responsible physician.




