ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW, on this 16th day of August, 1997, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, sitting as a whole, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, at the request of Dana L. Jordan, P.A. (hereinafter "Applicant") to grant a third temporary registration to practice as a physician's assistant in the State of Kansas.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). Applicant appears in person *pro se*. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for third temporary registration was received from Dana L. Jordan on July 1, 1997.

2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 1:15 p.m. on August 16, 1997 was filed herein on July 31, 1997 and served on Applicant on that same date.

3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as an physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a.

4. Applicant was granted temporary registration number 9722099, which expired June 30, 1997.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. The Board finds that good cause exists to grant Applicant a third temporary registration to expire February 28, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary registration be granted to Applicant.

B. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for

Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
