FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 25th day of April, 1998, this matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") sitting as a whole, the application of Sitaram G. Kadekar, M.D., ("Applicant") for a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

Charlene Abbott, Licensing Administrator of the Board, presented information to the Board. Applicant appeared *pro se*.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On July 3, 1996, Applicant filed an Application to obtain a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

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2. As part of the application, Applicant has been unable to complete Section X of the Application for Licensure by Endorsement as it has been nearly 40 years since graduation from Seth GS Medical College in Bombay, India and Applicant's medical school records have been archived at the Bombay Corporation warehouse. Repeated efforts by Applicant to have officials retrieve Applicant's school records have failed.

3. Applicant has provided verification of having had a medical license in Texas, Oklahoma, North Carolina, Georgia and Michigan and is eligible for a license by endorsement under K.S.A. 65-2833.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the requirements of Certification of Professional College in Section X of the Application for Endorsement has been substantially met and no further documentation is required for completion of Section X.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite to seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
