FINAL ORDER

WHEREUPON, having the agency record before it, hearing the testimony of Licensee, hearing the statements and arguments of counsel and being duly advised in the premises, the Board FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

1. On or about May 14, 2009, Licensee requested that he be allowed to supervise more than two (2) physician assistants so he can maintain adequate coverage in his practice during an anticipated maternity leave of one of his current physician assistants.
2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-28a10 the Board grants Licensee’s request so long as he is not supervising more than the equivalent of two (2) full-time physician assistants.


