ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW, on this 11th day of April, 1992, comes on for conference proceedings the request of Carolyn Kimoden, PT (hereafter "Applicant") to grant Third Temporary Permit pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1.

Steve A. Schwarm appears on behalf of the Board. Applicant appears in person pro se. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the files, hearing statements of Applicant and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1. A request for a Third Temporary Permit was filed by Applicant on March 13, 1992.

2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on April 11, 1992 was filed herein on March 27, 1992 and served on Applicant on that same date.

3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a physical therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2906.

4. Applicant was granted Temporary Permit No. H44669 effective May 8, 1991 which expired on August 15, 1991 and was

subsequently granted a second temporary permit number H45835 effective August 16, 1991 which expired on February 15, 1992.

5. Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1, not more than two temporary permits shall be issued to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board and only for good cause shown.

6. Applicant was unable to enter the United States until November 1991 during the effective period of the second temporary permit and Applicant did not practice as a physical therapist during the first temporary permit period.

7. Upon providing a second signed photograph, Applicant should be granted a third temporary permit until the results from the examination to be administered in July, 1992 are known to the Board and registrations based on such examination are issued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, upon providing a second signed photograph, a third temporary permit be granted to Carolyn Kimoden until the results from the examination to be administered in July, 1992 become known and registrations based on such examination are issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Applicant fails to pass the examination to be administered in July, 1992, the third temporary permit hereby authorized to Applicant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the Board meeting next following the failure becomes known to the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The

filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
