FINAL ORDER DISMISSING EMERGENCY PETITION

NOW on this 10th day of December, 1993, the Initial Order Dismissing Emergency Petition comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") sitting as a whole.

Licensee's Motion for Reconsideration of Licensee's Temporary Suspension came before a Hearing Panel consisting of Donald B. Bletz, M.D., Howard D. Ellis, M.D. and John P. Gravino, D.O. pursuant to K.S.A. 77-512, 77-536 and 65-2836(i), and was conducted in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*

After hearing the evidence and reviewing the proposed restrictions as stated by Licensee, the Hearing Panel made the following findings:

(1) Licensee has voluntarily agreed to have his Kansas license to practice medicine and surgery placed on inactive status pending resolution of the above-captioned cases. Licensee will execute a change of status form memorializing his license as inactive.

(2) Based upon Licensee's agreement to place his license on inactive status, no immediate or imminent danger exists to the public health, safety and welfare.


THEREFORE the Board as a whole ratifies the following orders:

- (2) The Emergency Petition is vacated and dismissed without prejudice.


IT IS SO ORDERED.


