

3. Applicant passed all 3 steps of the USMLE between 1996 and 1998 as required by K.S.A. 65-2873.

4. Applicant completed an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training program with St. Francis Hospital of Evanston in Evanston, Illinois on June 1999. Applicant then completed an ACGME accredited residency program at the same facility in June 2001. Applicant participated in an ACGME accredited fellowship at the University of California in San Francisco in Cardiology from July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007. Applicant then participated in an ACGME accredited fellowship at the University of Wisconsin in Madison, Wisconsin in Pulmonary Critical Care from July 2005 to June 2008. Finally, Applicant also participated in an ACGME accredited fellowship at University of Iowa in Iowa City, Iowa in Interventional Pulmonary from July 2008 to June 2009.

5. Applicant is currently licensed to practice medicine in the State of Colorado, having been licensed in 2009. There are no reported disciplinary actions against Applicant's California license.

6. Applicant is also currently licensed to practice medicine in the State of Iowa, having been licensed in 2011. There are no reported disciplinary actions against Applicant's Massachusetts license.

7. Applicant previously held licenses in the States of Wisconsin and Illinois, having been issued licenses in 2001 and 2000, respectively. There are no reported actions against Applicant's licenses in either of these states.


8. Applicant received his Education Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certification in November 1997.

9. The Board finds that Applicant has provided satisfactory proof of his medical school education by virtue of his licenses in other states.

10. The Board finds that Applicant has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
