

NOW, on this 22 day of April, 2008, the above-entitled matter comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas Board of Healing Arts ("Board"). After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations:

1. On March 28, 2008, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Board, issued a Summary Order Under Board Policy #05-04 in which it was determined that Cory L. Koch, D.C. should be assessed a fine in the amount of \$500.00, payable within 30 days of the effective date of the order, for failure to have met the continuing education requirements at the time he renewed his license and should provide documentation of completion of at least eight (8) continuing education credits in Category I before July 1, 2008.


2. The Summary Order was filed and mailed on March 31, 2008, and contained a notice that it would become effective within 15 following service if no request for hearing was received prior to the effective date of the Summary Order.

2. No hearing has been requested by any party and, therefore, the Summary Order became effective on April 21, 2008; the fine in the amount of \$500 is due and payable on or before May 21, 2008; and, as stated in the Summary Order, documentation

of completion of at least eight (8) continuing education credits in Category I shall be provided on or before July 1, 2008.



Summary Order Under Board Policy #05-04

NOW, on this 28th day of March 2008, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. License number 01-04129 issued to Cory L. Koch ("Licensee") to practice as a doctor of chiropractic medicine in the state of Kansas expired on December 31, 2007, pursuant to K.A.R. 100-15-1.

2. K.A.R.100-15-5 requires each Licensee desiring to renew a doctor of chiropractic medicine license to submit to the Board documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 50 CME hours with a minimum of 20 hours of Category I and a maximum of 30 hours of Category II for hours earned July 1, 2006 through December 31, 2007, or 100 CME hours with minimum of 40 hours Category I and a maximum of 60 hours of Category II for hours earned July 1, 2005 through December 31, 2007, or 150 hours with a minimum of 60 hours Category I and a maximum of 90 hours of Category II for hours earned July 1, 2004 through December 31, 2007.

3. On or about January 2, 2008, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of the license.

4. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding proof of continuing education had been read, the completion of 50 continuing education hours had been achieved since July 2006, and that documentation of those hours would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

5. As part of the renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing continuing education compliance had been read.

6. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing education requirements and on February 28, 2008, was mailed a letter requesting that Licensee provide, no later than March 31, 2008, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of 50 continuing education hours.

7. On March 4, 2008, Licensee provided copy of the CME records, which provided documentation that 12 Category I hours and a maximum number of Category II hours of continuing education had been obtained.

8. Licensee has failed to provide documented evidence of completion of 20 Category I continuing education contact hours since July 1, 2006.

9. Based on the Policy Statement No. 05-04, a Licensee who has deficient continuing education hours shall complete twice the number of deficient continuing education hours within 90 days and be fined the sum of \$500.00.

10. Based on the information provided by Licensee, Licensee was deficient a total of 8 Category I continuing education hours when the license was renewed; therefore, Licensee needed to complete an additional 16 Category I continuing education hours in accordance with Policy Statement No. 05-04.

8 On March 28, 2008, Licensee provided documentation that he had obtained eight (8) additional hours of Category I continuing education on March 10, 2008 through March 24, 2008.

9. The fine in the amount of \$500.00 was received in the Board office on March 28, 2008.


10. By providing documentation of eight (8) continuing education hours obtained on March 10, 2008 through March 24, 2008, Licensee must complete an additional eight (8) hours of Category I continuing education hours.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Licensee shall provide documentation of completion of eight (8) hours of Category I continuing education hours on or before July 1, 2008.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. 
