FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 12th day of August, 1995, comes on for conference proceedings before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") the request of Odongo John K'Omoga (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, and Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, presented information before the Board. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the files, hearing statements of the Executive Director and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1. A request for a second temporary registration was received from Applicant on July 27, 1995.

2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing on August 12, 1995 was filed herein on July 28, 1995 and served on Applicant on that same date.

3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a occupational therapist, but has not taken and passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5406.

4. Applicant was granted a temporary registration on May 24, 1994 which expired on May 25, 1995.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d) no more than one such temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. Applicant is intending to sit for the January, 1996 AOTCB examination.

7) Upon payment of the appropriate fee, Applicant should be granted a second temporary registration which shall be valid from August 12, 1995 until the occurrence of any one of the following:

- a) Applicant, prior to March 30, 1996, provides proof of successful passage of the next AOTCB examination, then the temporary registration will be cancelled on the date the Board issues a permanent registration to Applicant; or
- b) Applicant, prior to March 30, 1996, fails to provide proof of passage of the next AOTCB examination, then the temporary registration will be cancelled and of no further force or effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a) That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to Applicant which will be valid from August 12, 1995 until cancelled as provided in paragraph 7 above.

b) This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days of service, file a written request with this office for administrative review of this order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
