INITIAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 25th Day of November 2003, comes before the Presiding Officers an application for reinstatement of a license to practice chiropractic. Having heard the statements of the Applicant, Chad Allen Krier, the Presiding Officers find, conclude and order as follows:

1. The Board previously licensed Applicant through examination, issuing a license to practice chiropractic February 13, 1999. That license was not renewed, and the Board cancelled the license in November 1999.

2. Applicant entered the Bastyr University program of Naturopathic Medicine in 1999, and graduated with the degree of Doctor of Naturopathy in Spring 2003. This is a formal educational program.

3. The Board may grant reinstatement of a license to practice the healing arts if the applicant was engaged in a formal educational program in the two-year period preceding the application for reinstatement.

4. Good cause has been shown to grant the application for reinstatement.

5. Applicant states on the record that the Board may conduct review of the Initial Order at its regularly scheduled meeting on December 6, 2003, and that any objection to notice being less than ten days is waived.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT the application for reinstatement is granted.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is an Initial Order. An Initial Order is not effective until either the Board has conducted review, or until the time for requesting review has passed.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that Board will, on its own motion, review this Initial Order at its regularly scheduled meeting, December 6, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and at the conclusion of the review issue a Final Order. Upon conducting review, the Board may exercise all of the decision-making authority as if it had heard the matter itself.
