FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 13th day of February, 1993, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole the request of Donald E. Kuenzi, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for acceptance of a late renewal of license in lieu of adhering to the standard reinstatement procedures.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, and order:

1. Applicant was issued license number 4-10485 to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas originally on June 15, 1953.

2. On August 20, 1991, Applicant's license was cancelled for failure to renew in a timely fashion.

3. On November 18, 1992, the Board office received Applicant's request to receive reinstatement forms.

4. On December 11, 1992, the Board office received Applicant's completed renewal form for the period of July 1, 1992

to June 30, 1993, accompanied by a license status form requesting exempt status.

5. On December 15, 1992, Applicant was instructed by letter that the renewal period had concluded and that he would be required to apply for reinstatement.

6. In a letter to the Board office, Applicant expressed his desires to address the Board as a whole and request that he be allowed to renew his cancelled license and not be required to proceed with the process of reinstatement.

7. A Notice of Conference Hearing was prepared and served by mail to Applicant on January 25, 1993 setting the matter for hearing before the Board at its meeting February 13, 1993 at 9:00 a.m.

8. Applicant has failed to provide good cause for the granting of renewal of his license status in lieu of undergoing the reinstatement process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that in order to obtain a current license in the state of Kansas, Applicant will be required to undergo the established process required for reinstatement of cancelled licenses.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
