AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

NOW, on this 27th day of April, 1993, comes on for consideration before the Hearing Panel appointed as Presiding Officer by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"), the joint request of counsel for dismissal of the Emergency Petition filed in the Board office on November 6, 1992 in the above entitled matter. No appearances are necessary since counsel for the parties have previously approved and jointed submit the proposed Order of Dismissal.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings and order:

1. On November 6, 1992, an Emergency Petition was filed in the Board office pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536. Said Emergency Petition was filed as a result of investigatory information provided to the Board on or around August 15, 1992 which indicated that Robert A. Lado, D.C. (hereafter "Licensee") may have constituted an imminent danger to the public health, safety and welfare to the citizens of this state due to inappropriate patient care due to other inappropriate behavior or conduct indicating a lack of ability to competently practice the chiropractic branch of the healing arts in Kansas.

2. That from and since the filing of the Emergency Petition, Licensee has provided information that has served to allay any concerns that any imminent danger to the public health, safety and welfare exists.

3. That due to the information provided by Licensee and since the filing of the Emergency Petition, counsel for the parties have mutually agreed to the dismissal of the cause of action relating to the emergency proceedings under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.

4. Counsel have no objections to the dismissal of the Emergency Petition in its entirety and the dissolution of the Hearing Panel appointed on November 6, 1992 to conduct emergency proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that the Emergency Petition filed on November 6, 1992 in the above entitled matter be dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
