**JOURNAL ENTRY OF FINAL ORDER AND
SATISFACTION OF SUMMARY ORDER**

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or January 7, 2014, in accordance with K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 77-537 and 77-514, and as authorized by K.S.A. 65-2836, a Summary Order was issued ordering a civil fine and completion of twenty-eight (28) hours of continuing medical education credits against the license of Michael B. Lambert, M.D. (“Licensee”) for failing to provide to the Board documented evidence of completion of his continuing education requirements as required for renewal of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542, the Summary Order notified Licensee that if a written request for hearing was not filed within 15 days following service of the Summary Order, the Summary Order would become effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.

3. Licensee did not request a hearing on the Summary Order.

4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-526 and 77-530, the Summary Order became effective as a Final Order on January 27, 2014.

5. On or about February 6, 2014, Licensee remitted full payment in the amount of \$500.00 to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts.


6. On or about February 6, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation evidencing completion of twenty-eight (28) hours of continuing medical education credits as set forth in the Summary Order.

7. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Summary Order and has no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Summary Order filed on January 7, 2014.
