ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 29th day of April, 1995, this matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as presiding officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535 the Application for Reinstatement submitted James A. Lasseter, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant").

Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, appeared and presented information on the application to the Board.

Applicant appeared in person. (Confidential)

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On March 1, 1993, the Board and Applicant entered into a Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order which was filed in the Board office on March 2, 1993. In said document,

Applicant acknowledged that on January 28, 1993, Applicant had voluntarily suspended his practice of medicine and surgery and had placed his license on an inactive status. (Confidential) ,

2. Applicant failed to renew his license for the period of July 1, 1993 through June 30, 1994 and, therefore, his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas was cancelled on August 23, 1993.

3. On April 4, 1995, Applicant filed an Application for Reinstatement of his license together with an application that such license, if reinstated, be placed on exempt status.

5. The Board has not received reports from the American Medical Association and the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States, Inc. in order for Applicant's Application for Reinstatement to be deemed complete.

6. Applicant's Application for Reinstatement should be granted and Applicant's license to practice medicine and surgery in

the State of Kansas should be reinstated on an exempt status at such time as Applicant has provided all documents and reports necessary to make the application complete as determined by Board staff.

7. The Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order filed March 2, 1993 should be terminated and no longer have any further force or effect.

8. In the event Applicant desires to convert his license to active status, Applicant shall be required to comply with all requirements of the Board and the Board may consider all previous investigative information and formal proceedings in determining Applicant's present competency in determining if the status of his license should be converted to active.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

a) The findings here and above made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board.

b) Licensee's license number 4-18738 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas should be reinstated on an exempt status upon said application being deemed complete by Board staff.

c) The Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order filed March 2, 1993 between Applicant and the Board is hereby terminated and Applicant is released from the provisions as set forth in the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order. Further any and all limitations which were imposed on Applicant's

license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas by virtue of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order are removed.


d) Should Applicant desire to convert his license to active status, he will comply with all requirements of the Board then made and the Board may consider all past proceedings and investigative information in determining if the license status of Applicant's license should be converted to active.

e) This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
