JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION
OF REQUIREMENTS OF FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this 2nd day of March 2010, this matter comes before Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Interim Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), concerning Licensee's satisfaction of all requirements contained in the Final Order which was filed on January 21, 2010. Wherefore, the Board finds as follows:

1. On or about January 20, 2010, the Board issued a Final Order regarding the license of Otis S Latimer, M.D. ("Licensee") to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. The Final Order contained a provision for Licensee to pay a fine in the amount of \$500 within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the Summary Order. The Summary Order became effective January 7, 2010.

2. Licensee paid the \$500 fine on January 19, 2010.

3. On or about January 20, 2010, the Board issued a Final Order regarding the license of Otis S Latimer, M.D. ("Licensee") to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. The Final Order contained a provision for the Licensee to submit proof of 11 hours of category II continuing education, due within fifteen (15) days of the effective date of the Summary Order. The Summary Order became effective January 7, 2010.

4. Licensee submitted 154 hours of category II continuing education on January 19, 2010.

5. On or about January 20, 2010, the Board issued a Final Order regarding the license of Otis S Latimer, M.D. ("Licensee") to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. The Final Order contained a provision for the Licensee to submit proof of malpractice insurance or change the his designation to Federal Active, due within fifteen (15) days of the effective date of the Summary Order. The Summary Order became effective January 7, 2010.


6. Licensee changed his designation to Federal Active on February 16, 2010; therefore he is not required to submit proof of malpractice insurance.

7. Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Final Order and has no further obligation for compliance.

ITS IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from the requirements of the Final Order filed on January 21, 2010.



FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this 20th day of January 2010, this matter comes before Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Interim Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts. After reviewing the file and being advised in the premises, the Interim Executive Director makes the following determinations.

1. On December 15, 2009 the Interim Executive Director issued a Summary Order regarding the license of Otis S Latimer, M.D. ("Licensee") to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. The Summary Order contained a provision for the Licensee to submit proof of 150 hours of continuing education, due within fifteen (15) days of the effective date of the Summary Order.

2. On December 15, 2009, the Interim Executive Director issued a Summary Order regarding the license of Otis S Latimer, M.D. ("Licensee") to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. The Summary Order contained a provision assessing a \$500 civil fine against Licensee for failure to have met the continuing education requirement at the time of renewal, due and payable within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the Summary Order.

3. The Summary Order contained a notice that a written request for hearing could be filed within 15 days following service, but if no hearing is requested, the Summary Order would

be come effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the time for the requesting a hearing.

4. No hearing has been requested by any party; therefore the Summary Order became effective as a final order on January 4, 2010.



SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 15th day of December, 2009, this matter comes before Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Interim Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. Otis S Latimer, MD ("Licensee") was originally issued license number 04-32012 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas on August 12, 2006.
2. On or about June 29, 2009, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of their license.
3. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding proof of continuing education had been read, that 150 hours of continuing education hours had been achieved, and that documentation of those hours would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.
4. As part of the renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing continuing education compliance had been read.
5. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding professional liability insurance had been read, that compliance had been achieved, and that

documentation of the professional liability insurance policy would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

6. As part of the renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing professional liability insurance compliance had been read.

7. K.A.R. 100-15-5 requires each Licensee desiring to renew a Medicine and Surgery license to submit to the Board documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 50 contact hours of continuing education with a minimum 20 hours category I and maximum 30 hours category II since January 1, 2008, or 100 contact hours of continuing education 40 hours category I and maximum 60 hours category II since January 1, 2008, or 150 contact hours of continuing education 60 hours category I and maximum 90 hours category II since January 1, 2006, before or with the request for renewal.

8. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing education requirements and professional liability insurance on August 15, 2009, a letter was mailed to Licensee requesting that Licensee provide no later than September 20, 2009, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education hours and professional liability insurance.

9. On September 18, 2009, Licensee provided documentation of the achievement of 57 hours of category I and 0 hours of category II. Licensee also submit proof of professional liability insurance, did not show compliance with the Kansas Health Care Stabilization Fund.

10. On September 22, 2009, a letter was mailed advising the Licensee that he was deficit 3 hours of category I and 90 hours of category I or II. The letter also requested that he submit proof of compliance with the Kansas Health Card Stabilization Fund.

11. On October 14, 2009, Licensee provided documentation of the achievement of 70 hours of category I and 12 hours of category II.

12. On October 14, 2009, a letter was mailed advising the Licensee that he was deficit 11 hours of category I or II. The letter also requested that he submit proof of compliance with the Kansas Health Card Stabilization Fund or if you are working in a federal facility that you would need to change your designation to Federal Active.

13. A second letter requesting proof of continuing education and professional liability insurance with compliance in the Kansas Health Care Stabilization Fund by October 20, 2009 was sent to licensee on September 23, 2009 by certified mail through the United States Postal Service.

14. On September 24, 2009 the certified letters as signed for by a representative for the licensee.

15. By certifying that the licensee had met the requirement for renewal, Licensee violated K.S.A. 65-2836 (k), violated any lawful rule and regulation promulgated by the Board or violated any lawful order or directive of the Board previously entered by the Board. Specifically Licensee violated K.A.R. 100-15-5.

16. In addition to any other penalty prescribed under the healing arts act, K.S.A. 65-2863a authorizes the Board to assess an administrative fine in an amount not exceeding \$5,000 for the first violation of the healing arts act.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Licensee be assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$500, payable within thirty days of the effective date of this order, for failure to have met the continuing education requirement at the time of renewal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you shall submit proof that you have met your continuing education requirement and professional liability insurance with proof of compliance with the Kansas Health Care Stabilization Fund for the previous year to the Board with fifteen days following service of this summary order. Your license may be suspended if the records are not received by that date.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. A request for a hearing must be addressed to Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Interim Executive Director, 235 South Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603.
