

BEFORE THE KANSAS BOARD OF HEALING ARTS

IN THE MATTER OF THE
CHIROPRACTIC PRACTICE OF
CHARLES W. LAVALLEY, II, D.C.

AGREED ORDER

1. Charles W. LaValley, II, D.C., (Dr. LaValley) holds a license to practice chiropractic medicine issued by the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (the Board) in accordance with the laws of the State of Kansas.

2. The Board has received a complaint that Dr. LaValley ran an advertisement in the Topeka Capital-Journal on or about February 14, 1990, in which he was not identified as a doctor of chiropractic medicine.

3. On March 22, 1990, Dr. LaValley voluntarily appeared before the Board's Chiropractic Review Committee and he admitted that he had inadvertently failed to identify himself as a doctor of chiropractic medicine in the advertisement in question.

4. The Chiropractic Review Committee has recommended a public censure based on Dr. LaValley's advertisement on or about February 14, 1990, and Dr. LaValley has voluntarily stipulated to the public censure.

5. Nothing in this Order should be deemed as an admission of any violation of Kansas law by Dr. LaValley.

9. This Order may not be modified or amended without the mutual consent of both Dr. LaValley and the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Charles W. LaValley, II, D.C., should be and hereby is publicly censured for failing to identify himself as a doctor of chiropractic medicine in an advertisement in the Topeka Capital-Journal on or about February 14, 1990.
