- 1. On March 24, 2010 the Executive Director issued a Summary Order regarding the license of Darren Layton, O.T. ("Licensee") to practice as an occupational therapist in the state of Kansas. The Summary Order contained a provision for the Licensee to submit proof of 40 hours of continuing education, due within fifteen (15) days of the effective date of the Summary Order.
- 2. On March 24, 2009, the Executive Director issued a Summary Order regarding the license of Darren Layton, O.T. ("Licensee") to practice as an occupational therapy in the state of Kansas. The Summary Order contained a provision assessing a \$100 civil fine against Licensee for failure to have met the continuing education requirement at the time of renewal, due and payable within fifteen (15) days of the effective date of the Summary Order.
- 3. The Summary Order contained a notice that a written request for hearing could be filed within 15 days following service, but if no hearing is requested, the Summary Order would

be come effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the time for the requesting a

hearing.

4. No hearing has been requested by any party; therefore the Summary Order

became effective as a final order on April 13, 2010.

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# SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS Aday of December, 2009, this matter comes before Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Interim Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

- Darren Layton, OT ("Licensee") was originally issued license number 17-02034 to practice as an occupational therapist in the State of Kansas on November 6, 2001.
- On or about March 30, 2009, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of their license.
- Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5412 and K.A.R. 100-54-7 each Licensee desiring to renew a occupational therapy assistant license must have completed at least 40 credits of continuing education and to provide proof of completion to the Board upon request
- 4. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding continuing education had been read, that compliance had been achieved, and that documentation of the continuing education would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.
- Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing requirements and on June 16, 2009, a letter was mailed to Licensee requesting that

Licensee provide no later than July 20, 2009, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education.

- A second letter requesting proof of continuing education by August 7, 2009 was sent to licensee on July 21, 2009 by certified mail through the United States Postal Service. This certified letter was returned to the Board on August 12, 2009 unclaimed
- A third letter requesting proof of continuing education by September 15, 2009
  was sent to licensee on August 27, 2009 by certified mail through the United States Postal
  Service to her practice address on file.
- The third request letter was signed for by a representative for the licensee on September 1, 2009.
- Licensee failed to provide documented evidence of continuing education by the due date.
- 10. By failing to provide documented evidence of her continuing education, Licensee has violated K.S.A. 65-5410(4), violating any lawful order or rule and regulation of the Board. Further, Licensee violated K.A.R. 100-54-5(g), failing to furnish the Board or it representative any information legally requested by the Board.
- 11. In addition to any other penalty prescribed under the Occupational Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-5410(c) authorizes the Board to assess an administrative fine in an amount not exceeding \$5,000 for the first violation of the Occupational Therapy Practice Act.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED Licensee is hereby fined \$100 for failure to respond to the Board's legal request for information. The fine is due within thirty days of the effective date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that licensee shall submit proof of the continuing education requirements for the previous year to the Board with in fifteen days of the effective date of this order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.
