**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW ON THIS 14<sup>TH</sup> day of August, 1999, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"), sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a Conference Proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533, the request of James D. Leahy, M.D., (hereafter "Licensee") for retroactive reinstatement of license. Licensee appears in person.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. Licensee was originally granted license number 04-20302 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas on December 9, 1983.
2. Licensee's license was canceled on August 1, 1998 pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2809, due to Licensee's failure to renew.
3. An application for reinstatement was completed, and the license was reinstated on June 28, 1999.
4. From August 1, 1998 until June 28, 1999, Licensee maintained professional liability insurance in compliance with Kansas law and had the required continuing education necessary to qualify for reinstatement.
5. By letter dated June 28, 1999, Licensee requested that the Board retroactively reinstate his license to practice medicine and surgery to August 1, 1998.
6. The failure of Licensee to renew his license and the cancellation of such license on

August 1, 1998 was due to inadvertency and mistake of Licensee.

**IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

- A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are the Order of the Board.
- B. That license number 04-20302 issued under K.S.A. 65-2831 to James D. Leahy, M.D. and originally reinstated June 23, 1998, be retroactively reinstated to August 1, 1998 to reflect that Licensee has continuously held a current license from and since August 1, 1998.
- C. That as a condition of the aforementioned retroactive reinstatement of license, an administrative fine in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) be assessed to Licensee for his inadvertence and mistake in allowing his license to be canceled for nonrenewal on August 1, 1998. Payment of said fine to be received in the Board office within thirty (30) days of service of this Order.
- D. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


