

other state, District of Columbia, Territory or foreign country are determined by the board to be as high as those of this state. . . . "

4. On May 14, 1992, Applicant filed documents with the Board providing information on her successful completion of the National Board Examination in Germany as well as providing examples of the examination questions from that examination.

5. From the information submitted, the Board can not determine that the standards for registration in physical therapy in Germany are as high as those required in the state of Kansas.

6. From the information provided, as part of the application, it appears that the Applicant has graduated from an acceptable school of physical therapy in Germany and is allowed, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2906 to apply for registration by examination.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that Applicant is eligible, based upon her graduation from an acceptable school of physical therapy, to apply and sit for the examination required for registration as a physical therapist.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board can not determine that the standards for registration in physical therapy in Germany are as high as those in the state of Kansas and, therefore, Applicant should not be granted registration by endorsement under K.S.A. 65-2909(a) but that Applicant should be required to take and successfully pass the examination approved by the Board for registration as a physical therapist in this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
