**JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF CONSENT ORDER
AND TERMINATION OF SUSPENSION**

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, and upon due consideration of the agency record, applicable statutes and regulation, and being duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On March 20, 2017, Melissa Loseke, D.O. (“Licensee”) entered into a Consent Order as a condition of being granted licensure. The Consent Order was ratified by the Board on May 1, 2017.
2. The Consent Order required Licensee to attend and successfully complete the Ethics and Boundaries Course Program offered by the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians and pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.
3. The Consent Order suspended Licensee’s license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery until Licensee fulfilled the requirements of the Consent Order.
4. On May 5, 2017, the Board received documentation evidencing attendance and successful completion of the Ethics and Boundaries Course Program offered by the Center for Personalized Education.

5. On May 4, 2017, the Board received a \$1,000 payment for the civil fine assessed in the Consent Order.
6. Licensee has met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Consent Order. It is further ordered that the SUSPENSION of Licensee's license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery is hereby TERMINATED.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 800 SW Jackson St., Topeka, KS 66612.
