FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 12th day of June, 1993, comes on for Conference Hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole the application of Scott R. Luallin, M.D., (hereafter "Licensee") for retroactive modification of temporary permit status. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

 On June 24, 1988, Licensee was granted post graduate permit number 2810 to engage in post graduate training in the Department of Surgery at the University of Kansas Medical Center pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2811(a)(2).

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2811(b) the temporary permit issued under K.S.A. 65-2811(a)(2) authorizes the person receiving such permit to practice the appropriate branch of the healing arts in the post graduate training program while continuously so engaged but does not authorize the person receiving the permit to engage in the private practice of the healing arts. Pursuant to Board records, Licensee applied for and received his permanent license on December 7, 1990.

 On December 7, 1990 his post graduate permit was cancelled, the same date the permanent license was issued.

5. Licensee allowed the permanent license to be cancelled August 17, 1992 without realizing that because of the issuance of the permanent license to him, his post graduate permit had been cancelled.

 By letter received May 22, 1993, Licensee requested that temporary permit number 2810 be made retroactively effective to July 1, 1992.

7. The action of Licensee was due to lack of understanding, inadvertency and mistake in that Licensee allowed his permanent license to be cancelled without realizing that the post graduate temporary permit had been previously cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. That temporary permit number 2810 originally effective June 24, 1988 be retroactively reinstated to July 1, 1992 and be effective until June 30, 1993 when Licensee will complete his post graduate training program.

C. That to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas after June 30, 1993, Licensee will be required to have his permanent license reinstated.

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D. This is a Final Order and effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
