**FINAL ORDER**

On June 14, 2019, the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) held a Conference Hearing on Misty G. Luce’s (“Applicant”) application for licensure to practice as a Physical Therapy Assistant (“PTA”) in Kansas. Applicant appeared in person, and through counsel, Gary E. Laughlin, of Hamilton Laughlin Barker Johnson & Jones. Matthew Gaus, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared and presented the Response in Opposition to the application, on behalf of the Disciplinary Panel of the Board. The members of the Disciplinary Panel were recused from the Board’s consideration of this matter.

Upon review of the Applicant’s application, the Board’s Response in Opposition, exhibits submitted by both parties, oral arguments, and Applicant’s testimony at the Conference Hearing, the Board holds Applicant shall be publicly censured for violation of K.S.A. 65-2912(a)(5), as further defined by K.A.R. 100-29-12(a)(3), as she has had her PTA license suspended by the Texas Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, for conduct that would constitute grounds for disciplinary action in Kansas. The Board also holds Applicant shall be granted an Active license to practice as a PTA in Kansas.

**Final Order**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED**, that Applicant is **PUBLICLY CENSURED** for violating K.S.A. 65-2912(a)(5), as further defined by K.A.R. 100-29-12(a)(3), of the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Applicant's application for licensure as a PTA is **GRANTED**.


