ORDER OF RETROACTIVE MODIFICATION TO LICENSE STATUS

NOW, on this 11th day of December, 1992, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a summary proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1991 Supp 77-538, the request of Thomas E. Madaj, M.D., (hereafter "Licensee") for retroactive modification of license status. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the following findings are made:

1. Licensee was originally licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas on December 7, 1990.

2. On July 1, 1991, Licensee applied for renewal of his license for the period ending June 30, 1992.

3. On July 1, 1991, as part of his application for renewal of his license for the period July 1, 1991 through June 30, 1992, Licensee filed with the Board a Status Change Form on which he requested that his active license be changed to inactive active status and such request was processed by Board staff and the license status changed from active to inactive active status effective July 1, 1991.

4. That Licensee's license has remained on inactive active status from and since July 1, 1991.

5. That Licensee was current with his continuing education requirements, had obtained professional liability insurance in compliance with Kansas law and was eligible to have his license placed on active status during the period of time from July 1, 1991 to August 23, 1991 but due to misunderstanding or inadvertence, failed to do so.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the order of the Board.

B. The status of the license of the Licensee, Thomas E. Madaj, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas should be retroactively modified to reflect that Licensee held an active license from July 1, 1991 through and including August 23, 1991.

C. Licensee is entitled to an administrative review of this Order of Retroactive Modification to License Status if a written request is received in the Board office within 15 days of the date of service of this Order upon Licensee.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


