CONSENT ORDER FOR SURRENDER OF LICENSE

COMES NOW, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, ("Board"), by and through Associate Litigation Counsel, Brandy Snead, and Doug Magden, L.R.T. ("Licensee"), pro se, and move the Board for approval of a Consent Order affecting Licensee's license to practice as a radiologic technologist in the State of Kansas. The Parties stipulate and agree to the following:

- 1. Licensee's last known mailing address as provided to the Board is: Confidential Street, Olathe, KS 66062.
- 2. Licensee is entitled to engage in practice as a radiologic technologist in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 22-00846 on approximately September 28, 2005, and having last renewed such license on approximately October 1, 2011.
- 3. The Board is the sole and exclusive administrative agency in the State of Kansas authorized to regulate the practice of radiologic technologists. K.S.A. 65-7301 *et seq*.
- 4. This Consent Order and the filing of such document are in accordance with applicable law and the Board has jurisdiction to enter into the Consent Order as provided by K.S.A. 77-505. Upon approval, these stipulations shall constitute the findings of the Board, and this Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Final Order.

5. The Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act is constitutional on its face and as applied

in the case. Licensee agrees that in considering this matter, the Board is not acting beyond its

jurisdiction as provided by law.

6. Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives his right to a hearing. Licensee voluntarily and

knowingly waives his right to present a defense by oral testimony and documentary evidence,

to submit rebuttal evidence, and to conduct cross-examination of witnesses. Licensee

voluntarily and knowingly agrees to waive all possible substantive and procedural motions

and defenses that could be raised if an administrative hearing were held.

7. The terms and conditions of the Consent Order are entered into between the undersigned

parties and are submitted for the purpose of allowing these terms and conditions to become

an Order of the Board. This Consent Order shall not be binding on the Board until an

authorized signature is affixed at the end of this document. Licensee specifically

acknowledges that counsel for the Board is not authorized to sign this Consent Order on

behalf of the Board.

The Board has received information and investigated the same, and has reason to believe that

there may be grounds pursuant to K.S.A. 65-7313(a)(8), as further defined in K.A.R. 100-73-

6(d), to take action with respect to Licensee's license under the Kansas Radiologic

Technologists Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-7301, et seq.

9. Licensee was an employee with Shawnee Mission Medical Center (SMMC) for fourteen (14)

years. While Licensee was described as knowledgeable and a hard-worker. Confidential

c. Licensee was placed on a 60-day Performance Development Plan at the beginning of

11. Licensee's acts, if proven, constitute violations of the Kansas Radiologic Technologists

Practice Act as set forth in K.S.A. 65-7313. Specifically, grounds to discipline Licensee

include:

a. K.S.A. 65-7313(a)(8), in that Licensee has been found guilty of unprofessional conduct

under criteria which the board may establish by rules and regulations.

b. K.A.R. 100-73-6(d), in that Licensee was sanctioned or disciplined by a peer review

committee, or a medical care facility for acts or conduct that would constitute grounds

for denial, limitation, suspension, or revocation of a license under K.S.A. 65-7313 and

amendments thereto.

12. The Board has received information, investigated the same, and has reason to believe

allegations of unprofessional conduct occurred.

13. All pending investigation materials for Investigative No. 12-00119 regarding Licensee were

fully reviewed and considered by the Board members who serve on the Board's Disciplinary

Panel. On May 15, 2012, Disciplinary Panel No. 27 authorized and directed Board counsel

- 15. On August 7, 2012, Jennifer McArthur, Board Paralegal, spoke to Licensee who informed her of his decision to no longer practice radiologic technology in Kansas.
- 16. On August 11, 2012, Licensee emailed Ms. McArthur and stated that he did "not intend to practice any radiology connected employment in the future. [He did] not see any need to continue to be licensed in the state of Kansas."
- 17. On September 11, 2012, Licensee returned a phone call from Ms. McArthur and stated that Confidential

 Licensee agreed to surrender his license.
- 18. The Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act does not have an "inactive" status.

 Therefore, the purpose of this Consent Order is to ensure Licensee's inability to practice radiologic technology

- 19. Licensee waives his right to contest the allegations contained in this Consent Order and consents to a finding that there are grounds for the Board to pursue disciplinary action against his license.
- 20. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-7313, the Board may revoke Licensee's license; alternatively, Licensee may surrender his license.

21. Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-73-8(b) the Board has the authority to require successful completion

of an individually tailored program approved by the board prior to reinstatement of such

license.

22. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-505, the Board has authority to enter into this Consent Order without

the necessity of proceeding to a formal hearing.

23. Licensee's failure to comply with the provisions of the Consent Order may result in the

Board taking further disciplinary action as the Board deems appropriate according to the

Kansas Administrative Procedure Act and Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act.

24. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to deny the Board jurisdiction to investigate

alleged violations of the Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act, or to investigate

complaints received under the Risk Management Law, K.S.A. 64-4921 et seq., that are

known or unknown and are not covered under this Consent Order, or to initiate formal

proceedings based upon known or unknown allegations of violations of the Kansas

Radiologic Technologists Practice Act.

25. Licensee hereby releases the Board, its individual members (in their official and personal

capacity), attorneys, employees and agents, hereinafter collectively referred to as

"Releasees", from any and all claims, including but not limited to those alleged damages,

actions, liabilities, both administrative and civil, including the Kansas Judicial Review Act,

K.S.A. 77-601 et seq., arising out of the investigation and acts leading to the execution of this

Consent Order. This release shall forever discharge the Releasees of any and all claims or

demands of every kind and nature that Licensee has claimed to have had at the time of this

release or might have had, either known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, and Licensee

of any description against the Releasees.

26. Licensee further understands and agrees that upon signature by Licensee, this document shall

be deemed a public record and shall be reported to any reporting entities authorized to

receive disclosure of the Consent Order.

27. This Consent Order, when signed by both parties, constitutes the entire agreement between

the parties and may only be modified or amended by a subsequent document executed in the

same manner by the parties.

28. Licensee agrees that all information maintained by the Board pertaining to the nature and

result of any complaint and/or investigation may be fully disclosed to and considered by the

Board in conjunction with the presentation of any offer of settlement, even if Licensee is not

present. Licensee further acknowledges that the Board may conduct further inquiry as it

deems necessary before the complete or partial acceptance or rejection of any offer of

settlement.

29. Licensee, by signature to this document, waives any objection to the participation of the

Board members, including the Disciplinary Panel and General Counsel, in the consideration

of this offer of settlement and agrees not to seek the disqualification or recusal of any Board

member or General Counsel in any future proceedings on the basis that the Board member or

General Counsel has received investigative information from any source which otherwise

may not be admissible or admitted as evidence.

30. Licensee acknowledges that he has read this Consent Order and fully understands the

contents.

31. Licensee acknowledges that this Consent Order has been entered into freely and voluntarily.

- 32. All correspondence or communication between Licensee and the Board relating to the Consent Order shall be by certified mail addressed to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 800 SW Jackson, Lower Level Suite A, Topeka, Kansas 66612.
- 33. Upon execution of this Consent Order by affixing a Board authorized signature below, the provisions of this Consent Order shall become an Order under K.S.A. 77-505 and K.S.A. 77-526. This Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Final Order when filed with the office of the Executive Director for the Board and no further Order is required.
- 34. The Board may consider all aspects of this Consent Order in any future matter regarding Licensee.
- 35. In lieu of conducting a formal proceeding, Licensee, by signature affixed to this Consent Order, hereby voluntarily agrees to the following disciplinary action on his license to engage in the practice of radiologic technologist:

SURRENDER

- a. Licensee hereby surrenders his license to practice as a radiologic technologist. Such surrender shall be treated as a revocation for all purposes, including reporting. Licensee agrees that an application for reinstatement of the license will be considered in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 65-7307 and K.A.R. 100-73-8.
- b. Licensee agrees that in the event he applies for reinstatement of his license, the allegations contained in this Consent Order will be considered as findings of fact and conclusions of law.
