**ORDER OF TERMINATION OF STIPULATION**

NOW on this 14th day of October, 1995, comes for conference hearing before the full Board Licensee's request for termination of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order of July 5, 1994 between James A. Maliszewski ("Licensee") and the Board of Healing Arts ("Board"). Kevin K. LaChance, Disciplinary Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board. Licensee appears in person *pro se*.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order ("Stipulation") was entered into between Licensee and the Board on July 5, 1994.
2. Paragraph 10 of said Stipulation provides that Licensee may petition the Board for termination and/or modification of the Stipulation after three years, or upon the termination of the agreement between the Missouri State Board of Registration for the Healing Arts and Licensee, whichever comes first.

3. Licensee's agreement with the Missouri State Board of Registration was terminated pursuant to Order dated August 8, 1995, thus returning his Missouri license to its full privileges free and clear of all restrictions.

4. Licensee submitted his request for termination of the Kansas Stipulation on September 6, 1995.

5. Disciplinary Counsel for the Board does not oppose the termination of said Stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that any and all restrictions and limitations placed on Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas by the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order filed July 5, 1994 should be terminated and be of no further force or effect.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

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
