SUMMARY ORDER OF CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION

NOW, on this 14th day of July, 2003, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. The registration of Mary J. Martin, RPT ("Registrant") issued by the Board to practice as a physical therapist in the state of Kansas expired December 31, 2002.

2. On or about December 30, 2002, the Board received Registrant's application for renewal and a credit card authorization in the amount of \$70 for payment of the renewal fee for renewal of her registration for the period January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

3. At the time Registrant submitted the application for renewal, she requested an extension of time to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of a minimum of 40 contact hours of continuing education as required by K.A.R. 100-29-9.

4. Pursuant to Registrant's request and in accordance with K.A.R. 100-29-9 and the policies of the Board, on December 31, 2002, Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, notified

Registrant that her request had been granted and she had been given an extension of four months until April 30, 2003, to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of the continuing education required by K.A.R. 100-29-9.

5. As a result of the granting of the extension until April 30, 2003, Registrant's registration was renewed and Registrant was issued a wallet card indicating her registration was valid for the period of January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

5. As of the date of this order, Board staff has not received from Registrant evidence of satisfactory completion of continuing education.

6. As a result of Registrant's failure to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of continuing education, Registrant has not met the requirements for renewal of her registration for the period January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the registration of Registrant issued by the Board to practice as a physical therapist in the state of Kansas is canceled due to failure to renew as provided by K.S.A. 65-2901 *et seq.*, and specifically K.S.A. 65-2910(b).

This is a Summary Order and a party is entitled to a hearing if a written request for a hearing is filed with the Board office within 15 days of service of the Order on the party. If no request is received, this Summary Order will become immediately effective.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


