ORDER OF RETROACTIVE REINSTATEMENT

NOW, on this 8th day of December, 1989, comes on for hearing before the whole board sitting as presiding officer in a summary adjudicative proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-538, the application of James M. Martin, III, D.C., hereinafter referred to as "Licensee", for retroactive reinstatement of his license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. That Licensee was originally granted license number 1-3375 to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas on January 4, 1977.

2. That pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 65-2809, Licensee's license was cancelled on August 1, 1989, due to Licensee's failure to renew said license as specified in said statute.

3. That on August 15, 1989, Licensee filed in the board office an application for reinstatement of his license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas, together with other supporting documentation.

4. That Licensee continued to practice chiropractic from August 1, 1989 until August 15, 1989, although his license to so practice had been cancelled pursuant to the statutes of the State of Kansas.

5. That it appears the failure of Licensee to properly renew his license prior to cancellation on August 1, 1989 was due solely to inadvertence, negligence and mistake and was not due to any intentional conduct on the part of Licensee.

**IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the findings hereinabove made be and the same are made the order of the Board.

2. That the license of Licensee, James M. Martin, III, D.C., to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas should be retroactively reinstated to be effective from and after August 1, 1989.

3. That as a result of Licensee's negligence, inadvertence and mistake in failing to properly renew his license prior to its expiration and continuing to practice from the period August 1, 1989 until August 15, 1989 without proper authority to do so issued by the Board, Licensee should be fined the sum of \$100.00, which sum should be forthwith paid to the Board.

4. That Licensee is entitled to an administrative review of this Order of Reinstatement if a written request is received in the board office within fifteen (15) days of the date of service of this Order upon Licensee.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
