SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 15th day of August, 1992, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a summary proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 77-538, the request submitted by James M. Martin, III, D.C. (hereafter "Licensee") for an extension of time to provide proof of having attained a minimum of 50 continuing education hours the past year. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On July 28, 1992, the Board received Licensee's written request for an extension of time to submit the required continuing education hours necessary for renewal of his license to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas.

2. On July 30, 1992, Steve A. Schwarm, General Counsel for the Board, advised Licensee by letter that the matter would be addressed by the Board as a whole at its next regularly scheduled meeting to be held August 15, 1992.

SUMMARY ORDER
James M. Martin, III, D.C.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. That an extension to provide proof of having attained 50 continuing education hours required for renewal is granted to Licensee, James M. Martin, III, D.C., until Wednesday, August 19, 1992 at 4:30 p.m.. Such proof of completion shall be delivered, either by mail or in person to the Board office at 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, Kansas 66603-3068. In the event Licensee fails to provide proof of completion of the required continuing education hours, a fully completed application for renewal, proof of professional liability insurance and renewal and late fees totalling \$200 by 4:30 p.m. on August 19, 1992, the license of Licensee issued by the Board to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas will be immediately cancelled.

C. Applicant is entitled to an administrative review of this Order if a written request is received in the Board office within fifteen (15) days of the service of this Order upon Applicant.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
